Short self-evaluation of the PhD course "Peer-reviewing and getting published in international journals" (SOS9032)

This PhD course was held for the first-time spring 2023 and the course received on the whole very good feedback from the PhD students, which that the course was extremely useful and improved their knowledge about the peer-reviewing process and getting published in international journals. It was emphasized that the course was very practical in the sense that they got guidelines and input that they could implement directly into their own work. This was highly appreciated.

The course was structured as a small group so that the teaching could be adapted somewhat to what the students wanted and needed. The teaching was a combination between lecture and group work which was well received. Having a small group allowed all students to share their experienced and many appreciated that the course managed to create a safe leaning environment.

The course was held in three parts where the students worked on assignments between the meetings. One feedback was to have somewhat longer time between the second and the third part to give enough time to implement all the feedback they had gotten on their manuscript at the second. I will try to accommodate this for the course next year.
