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Teaching

During the <u>first-second and third semesters year</u> of the programme, three workshops will be organized to assist students in developing their master thesis projects. <u>The same workshops apply for both HGO4090 and HGO4080</u>. <u>Attendance to the workshops is voluntary, but sStudents are strongly encouraged expected</u> to participate in all workshops. Students will receive individual supervision by a member of the academic staff, the supervisor. Supervisors will be suggested for all students in the <u>first-second</u> semester of the master's degree programme <u>following the submission of a concept note-</u>

Compulsory instruction and coursework,

You are required to submit a concept note in the 2nd semester of programme. Failing to do so will delay the identification of potential supervisors. The completed and approved compulsory activity will be valid for the entire period the course is offered.

Absence from compulsory tuition activities

If you are ill or have another valid reason for being absent from compulsory tuition activities, your absence may be approved or the compulsory activity may be postponed.

Report absence from or the need for a postponed deadline on a compulsory tuition activity.

Access to teaching

A student who has completed compulsory instruction and coursework and has had these approved, is not entitled to repeat that instruction and coursework. A student who has been admitted to a course, but who has not completed compulsory instruction and coursework or had these approved, is entitled to repeat that instruction and coursework, depending on available capacity.
