

Agreement of supervision Department of Social Anthropology

This agreement specifies the supervision between

With regards to the master project:		
Supervision between supervisor and student is regulated in <i>Ethical guidelines for supervisors at the University of Oslo</i> . The supervisor is expected to know these guidelines.		
Scope and limitations		
The scope of supervision is limited to a total of 12 sessions: 3 sessions while developing the project proposal in the first semester; 1 session before fieldwork during the second semester; 3 during the third semester and 5 in the fourth semester. Guidance that covers more than 50 pages of the student's work, will count as two sessions. Unused sessions cannot be transferred to a later semester. In total, the student is entitled to supervision during four active semesters, including the field work/data collecting period. If the student for a period of time does <i>not</i> want supervision, the department and the supervisor must be notified.		
If the supervisor is unavailable for an extended period of time, the department will ensure that supervision is offered by another supervisor. Sessions already held are subtracted from the total amount of sessions in the case of change of supervisor.		
Termination of the agreement		
The agreement is terminated when one or more of the following situations occur:		
a) the stu	dent completes the final exa	amination of the master degree,
b) the stu	dent changes supervisor,	
c) the stu	dent has had the total amou	nt of supervision meetings and/or four semesters,
	the admission to the master programme is revoked, or	
e) the stu	student withdraws from the study programme.
