1st NORDIC STS CONFERENCE 2013 - blurb:

- “The field of science and technology studies (STS) has grown rapidly in the Nordic countries, and for some time, many Nordic scholars have expressed an interest in developing a Nordic meeting place for STS scholars. The initiative of organising a **first Nordic STS conference** coincides with an effort to create a Nordic STS network by strengthening intellectual ties between existing national networks. The main purpose of the 2013 Nordic STS conference is to stimulate scientific exchanges among STS scholars in the Nordic countries by providing a regional forum for presenting on-going work and initiating informal dialogues. Particularly young scholars wanting to share and discuss their work (but also more established scholars from both large and small STS institutions) are encouraged to take this opportunity for getting together with colleagues on a regional basis.”

6th Nordic STS i Oslo 2023: «Disruption and repair in and beyond STS»

“Climate change, pandemic outbreaks, war in Europe, terrorism in Nordic capitals and rising social inequalities: We live in times of disruption where crisis seems to become the new normal state. Indeed, disruption has itself been a longstanding concern within STS. How do STS empirics, methods and theories provide insights and tools for understanding not only the new and ongoing crises, but also their historical, technical and political continuities? And conversely, how can STS attention towards ordinary everyday practices to repair and maintenance, help us analyse and explain societal developments, past and present?”

This conference invites scholars in and beyond Nordic STS to take part in this conversation and to engage with emerging and longstanding topics in the field. In this first physical Nordic meeting since 2019, we seek to create a collective arena for exploring and rethinking STS scholarship and its role in society.”
